RE: REFERENCE LETTER: NGT HOLDINGS

This letter serves to confirm that we worked with Nkosinathi Tomose from NGT Holdings (Pty) Ltd (hereafter referred to as NGT Holdings) as heritage consultants and archaeologists on the proposed Ngwedi Turnings Eskom Deviations as Part of Ngwedi Turnings Transmission Line in the North West Province. They formed part of specialists for our environmental assessment practitioner – Baagi Environmental Consultancy CC. In the studies they were involved in the following:-

1. Preparation of Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) and Conservation Management Guidelines for inclusion in the Environmental Management Programmes.
2. Acquisition of heritage permits

The project had initially been issued to another heritage consultant and NGT was appointed to rescue the project and restart the HIA process from scratch. This was a very sensitive project because the proposed powerlines had the potential to impact on a Grade I site – the Late Iron Age Marothodi settlement. Based on NGT's submission, SAHRA was able to issue a ROD on the project with conditions that a Conservation Management Plan should be developed and implemented during the construction phase. This involved monitoring of potential impacts to these sites and reporting on their conditions.

We would recommend them for the proposed strategic document development and implementation.
